Thank-you for your email of this date.

Hoping for your indulgence, Reviewer 1 has repeated his review of a prior submission almost verbatim, including the completely wrong, indeed physically impossible, energy-balance analysis. See my analysis in item 10.2 in the Supporting Information, which explicitly explained the reviewer's error. It appears reviewer 1 remains unaware of his mistake.

Reviewer 1 also continues to misconstrue a physical uncertainty with an energetic perturbation. Reviewer 3 has made the same very basic mistake.

I believe illuminating these reviewer mistakes will obviate the notion that the manuscript is fatally flawed.
