Dear Dr Frank,

Your manuscript, number JOC-14-0602, entitled "Propagation of Error and the Reliability of Global Air Temperature Projections", has been withdrawn from International Journal of Climatology, for two main reasons detailed below.

First, your manuscript exceeds the limit imposed on the newly submitted manuscripts. The limit is 7500 words of the main text, that is, from the introduction up to acknowledgments. Second, your manuscript does not meet our journal's style in several aspects: For example, figures and tables should not be embedded within the text but supplied as separate files or attached at the end of the main document, respectively; and the literature citations in the text are in a wrong format.

You may re-submit your manuscript as a new submission after shortening it and putting it into accord with the journal's style (see [http://onlinelibrary.wiley.com/journal/10.1002/\(ISSN\)1097-0088/homepage/ForAuthors.html](http://onlinelibrary.wiley.com/journal/10.1002/(ISSN)1097-0088/homepage/ForAuthors.html)).
